The proposed project responds to the need of young people affected by conflict to be heard and shape future policies that will affect them the most. By telling individual stories and connecting those to STGs, NSL will start promoting a new conversation and sharing a new story of hope and inspiring change.

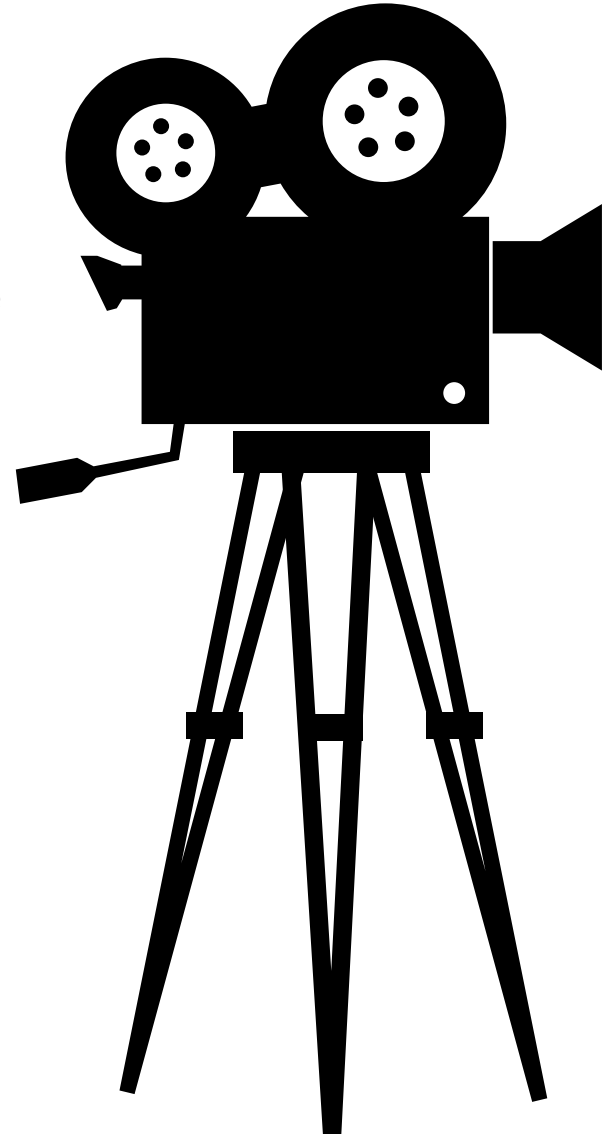
In an era of increased polarization, the younger generation in Israel, Palestine, and Ireland face a similar challenge—preparing to lead in times of uncertainty. Young leaders in conflict areas are especially vulnerable to political, environmental, and social injustice. As we face a global pandemic, an innovative approach to achieving Ireland’s Youth, Peace, and Security Agenda is essential.

The project will provide a team of 15 Palestinians, Israelis, and Irish participants with a three-day online leadership training seminar. Online Training Seminar will include but will not be limited to:

- Introduction to Advocacy Film Making
- Advocacy based Story-telling
- Digital Advocacy Strategies

Following the Online Training Seminar, five collaborative teams of three (Israelis, Irish, Northern Irish, and Palestinians) will team up together to produce a three-minute Digital Story Video addressing one of Ireland Policy International Development Priorities

- Gender Equality
- Climate Action
- Peace and Security
